Congress Government Built on Lies and Betrayal: Chalavadi Narayanaswamy Slams State Leadership

Bengaluru, July 23: Leader of Opposition in the Karnataka Legislative Council, Chalavadi Narayanaswamy, launched a scathing attack on the Congress-led state government, accusing it of being built on "lies, deceit, and fraud." Addressing the media at the BJP state office, 'Jagannath Bhavan', Narayanaswamy alleged that the Congress has a long history of cheating the people and continues to exploit the poor. "They are filling their coffers by squeezing small traders and street vendors through illegal tax notices, under the false pretense of central government directives," he said. He criticized the imposition of GST on marginal vendors, stating that notices have been issued even to tea and coffee sellers, despite the Centre not mandating such actions. "The government is misusing the GST Act to harass small traders and tarnish the Centre's image," he claimed. Narayanaswamy slammed the state government for holding a truncated Assembly session starting August 11. "It's a sham, meant only to pass bills and suppress opposition voices. They fear being questioned on issues like deaths due to RCB stampede, medicine shortages, and corruption in the Labor and Rural Development departments," he said. He also took aim at the Congress for deteriorating law and order and its alleged anti-Dalit stance, accusing the government of using police to cover up corruption. He said BJP and JDS MLAs had discussed a strategy to raise these concerns in the Council. On the MUDA scam, he maintained that the Supreme Court rejecting the ED plea does not mean Chief Minister Siddaramaiah is innocent. "The SC didn't give a clean chit. According to us, the CM remains an accused and cannot escape accountability," he said.

Opposition MLAs Deserve Equal Grants: Araga Gyanendra Slams Congress Govt's Bias

Bengaluru, July 23: Former Karnataka Minister and BJP leader Araga Gyanendra has demanded that the state government extend development grants to opposition MLAs on par with ruling party legislators, calling it a matter of fairness and public accountability. Speaking to the media at the BJP state office, Jagannath Bhavan, Gyanendra criticized the Congress government for selectively allocating funds. "This is not their personal money. It is taxpayers' money meant for the development of the entire state. Grants should be provided to opposition MLAs as well," he asserted. He accused the government of inflating the state budget merely to secure loans, while failing to distribute funds equitably. "They claim to have no money, yet only favor ruling party MLAs with grants. This is unacceptable in a democratic setup," he said. Welcoming the formation of a Special Investigation Team (SIT) in the Dharmasthala case, Gyanendra expressed concerns about external interference.

Shivamogga to Become Health Hub for Malnad Region: State Government Plans Major Medical Infrastructure Boost

Bengaluru, July 23: The Karnataka government is preparing a comprehensive blueprint to transform Shivamogga into a major health hub catering to the entire Malnad region. In a high-level meeting held at Vikasa Soudha on Wednesday, Dr. Sharanprakash R. Patil, minister for medical education, skill development, entrepreneurship and livelihood along with School Education and Shivamogga district in-charge minister Madhu Bangarappa, reviewed the infrastructure and service delivery at the Shivamogga Institute of Medical Sciences (SIMS) and Meggan Hospital.

BJP Will Stand by Small Traders: State President B.Y. Vijayendra Slams Govt's 'Illegal' GST Notices



Bengaluru, July 23: BJP State President and MLA B.Y. Vijayendra strongly criticized the Congress-led Karnataka government for targeting street vendors and small traders with GST-related notices, vowing that the BJP would fully support their struggle. Addressing the media at the BJP state headquarters 'Jagannath Bhavan', Vijayendra expressed serious concern over notices being served by the Commercial Tax Department to micro, small, and medium enterprises. "Traders are living in fear and anxiety, while the Chief Minister and cabinet are trying to pin the blame on the Centre," he said. Vijayendra recalled Chief Minister Siddaramaiah's earlier push for Karnataka to top GST collections, even surpassing Maharashtra. "Now, the same government is issuing illegal notices to traders in a desperate move to fill an empty treasury," he alleged, demanding the immediate withdrawal of these notices. He further questioned the rationale behind issuing GST notices on items like milk, which fall outside the GST ambit, and accused the government of applying a blanket 18% tax rate without proper verification. Touching on recent political clashes, Vijayendra warned the Congress against inciting its workers to provoke unrest near BJP offices, stating, "Our workers are capable too. Don't mistake our silence for weakness." Regarding the MUDA scam, he clarified that while the Supreme Court rejected the ED plea, it didn't exonerate CM Siddaramaiah, who remains an accused.

CM Siddaramaiah Assures Support to Small Traders Over GST Notice Issues

Bengaluru, July 23, 2025: Chief Minister Siddaramaiah chaired a meeting with representatives of various trade unions to discuss concerns over GST notices issued to small traders for non-payment of taxes. The meeting addressed grievances and proposed solutions to support small businesses.

Trade union representatives, including the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FKCCI), raised concerns about confusion among small traders regarding GST notices, which often include loan amounts and personal transactions. They urged the government to allow traders to directly resolve issues with the Commercial Tax Department without intermediaries and to provide sufficient time to settle dues. Suggestions included launching a dedicated helpline and conducting awareness programs to clarify GST regulations. They also requested a



one-time waiver of old tax arrears.

The Chief Minister clarified that notices were issued only to traders with UPI transactions exceeding Rs. 40 lakh, initially to prompt GST registration. He assured that no taxes would be collected from traders dealing in exempt goods like milk, vegetables, meat, and fruits, but those liable under the law must comply. He announced that old tax arrears would not be pursued, provided all

such traders register under the GST and start paying the GST in the future. The government emphasized its commitment to supporting small traders and ensuring lawful business operations. It will provide assistance for timely tax payments and enhance the existing helpline for better accessibility. The state, which ranks second in India for GST collection, shares 50% of the revenue with the central government, as decided by the GST Council chaired by the Union Finance Minister. The government assured transparent operations and help the traders in every possible way legally. Trade bodies confirmed they have not supported any bands and agreed to withdraw planned protests following the Chief Minister's assurances. The government reiterated its focus on empowering small traders and boosting purchasing power through various programs.

Vice President Dhankar's Health is Fine, But BJP's Health is rotten: Dr. Sharanprakash Patil



Bengaluru, July 23 : The resignation of vice president Jagdeep Dhankhar citing health reasons has sparked intense controversy, said Dr. Sharanprakash R. Patil, minister for medical education, skill development, livelihood and in-charge of Raichur district. Speaking to reporters in Bengaluru on Wednesday at Vikasa Soudha, the minister launched a sharp attack on the BJP. He said the sudden resignation of the vice president has surprised everyone. "The real reason behind this is the unhealthy condition of the BJP. The authoritarian attitude within the BJP is the key reason for Jagdeep Dhankhar's resignation," Dr. Patil alleged. "If we closely examine the entire episode, it's evident that something is amiss within the BJP. The party and Central government is being run by just two individuals. Due to the overpowering dominance, no other leader dares to speak out. The BJP assumes that people will remain unaware, but this entire incident has completely exposed the party," he added. Dr. Patil further criticized the BJP stating, "There is no democracy or adherence to rules within the party. Even the central government is not abiding by the Constitution. Has PM Narendra Modi ever held a press conference, the Congress PM Dr Manmohan Singh very often met the press? Most decisions are made unilaterally. These undemocratic practices are the reason behind the BJP's declining political health," he said.
